

INDEX OF ANCIENT PERSONS

Notes to the reader: persons are given by their *gentilicium*, where known; exceptions are authors, emperors, empresses, usurpers and a few others (Heraclianus, Papinianus, Paulus, Plautianus, Priscus, Seianus, Timesitheus, Ulpianus, Volusianus). Consulships or other distinguishing posts are added for the sake of clarity. Persons who occur in footnotes only are generally not included in this index. Authors are only included insofar as they occur in the main text; references in footnotes are usually not included in the index. Full names of emperors are only given for those emperors who reigned between AD 193 and 284.
