Brill publishes its Annual Report including audited Financial Statements

Today Brill published its audited financial statements. These are available at Brill.com. The annual report and financial statements will be on the agenda of the Annual General Meeting of Shareholders (AGM), to be held on 25 June, 2020. Information about the organization and physical and/or digital set-up of the AGM will follow in May together with the convocation notice and the agenda.

Versus the preliminary numbers published on 25 March 2020, Revenue and EBITDA were adjusted downward by EUR 0.2 million to EUR 37.1 million and by EUR 0.1 million to EUR 5.2 million respectively, following audit work relating mainly to revenue recognition. Net income increased by EUR 0.1 million despite the lower revenues, due to an adjustment in tax charges.

A trading update containing information on Brill's progress in the first quarter will be released on 21 April after market close.
