Each collection gives access to all online available content back to the year 2000. After unsubscribing perpetual access to collections is maintained for all years paid for.

- Long-term preservation of all electronic content is secured by arrangements with the Dutch National Library (NL), Portico (USA) and with CLOCKSS.
- [Brill Open](#) offers authors the option to secure open access for their journal contributions.
- Brill is committed to reflect a journal's Open Access income in the development of its subscription price. This price adjustment is determined by the change in the share of paid OA content. Following the year that this share exceeds 10%, measured from the last such price adjustment, this change in pricing will be applied. New journals will be excluded from this policy in the first five years of publication.
