#### **Brill Online Journal Collections and Brill Online Journal Archives**

Institutional customers may also wish to consider subscribing to the *Brill Online Journal Collection* or subject-specific collections. Each collection gives access to all online available content back to the year 2000. If an institution decides not to renew their subscription to the Collection, perpetual access to Collections is maintained for all years paid for.

The *Brill Journal Archives Online* (2017) offer access to over 5,500 volumes of 230 scholarly journals. The Journal Archives consist of two parts, the first covering the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> century and the second covering part of the 21<sup>st</sup> century.
