Online publishing has made possible the dissemination of research on an unprecedented, global, scale. **Open Access** takes full advantage of this potential.

Open Access expands **visibility**, increases **downloads**, and creates **more impact**. It continues to be an **essential topic in research policy making**, with **many funders and institutions** adopting **Open Access publishing recommendations** for researchers.

Since **2009**, Brill has been working with authors, editors, societies, institutions and funders to publish in Open Access.

This means Open Access is **seamlessly integrated in the publication process**.

We have published more than **400 Open Access books** and **25 Open Access journals**.

We recognize that **it can be challenging to find funding and support authors and editors to find Open Access budget**. We work with initiatives such as Knowledge Unlatched.

In addition, we collaborate with principal investigators of **projects with research funding**. We support authors and editors to be **compliant with research funder policy** and to find the best option to publish the results of the project.

To **maximize the dissemination** of our Open Access publications, we **share** them not just on our publication platform, but also in all of our library collections as well as dedicated platforms such as **JSTOR, OAPEN, and DOAB**.

We publish our Open Access publications in **print**, as well as **online**.
