



## Windows users

The EICD is a so-called Verity CD after the Verity Search Engine built in the CD. It was designed from 1999 onwards, before Windows Vista and Windows 7 existed.

Proper functioning under higher versions than Windows 98 and XP will NOT be guaranteed, because the search engine can not be updated any further.

However, on test machines with Windows XP or Windows Vista and Internet Explorer 8 the CD *may* run, given the appropriate permissions are set (see § 3 Administrator Rights), and the correct patches are installed.

Depending on the version of the CD, to run Verity CDs under Vista or XP, the file `webcdbrowser.exe` and or `search.exe` must be updated with a so-called "patch".

Please review the [questionnaire](#) which will help you identify any problems you might encounter, as well as information on the patch which can be downloaded for users of Windows XP and Windows Vista.

## Windows 7

To run the Verity Cds under Windows 7, the program must be installed in so-called Compatibility mode XP Sp3. First install all of the above patches in so-called Compatibility mode XP Sp3. Run all `setup.exe` programs in Compatibility mode XP Sp3. (<http://windows.microsoft.com/en-us/windows-vista/Make-older-programs-run-in-this-version-of-Windows>)

1. Right Click on the CD Icon | `setup.exe` | `setup.msi` or other installer or program
2. Click Properties
3. Look for the Tab "Compatibility Mode"
4. Select Windows XP Sp3
5. Close the Properties
6. double Click the Icon to start the application.

## Mac Users

First of all: the Mac version is out of sale. Copies might be obtained perhaps at Amazon.com. *Unfortunately*, the Mac CD does *not* run under OS 10.3 and higher, because it needs OS 9.2.2 to run ("under" OS X). So, the only solution would be to start up in OS 9. The CD needs Internet Explorer 5.1 for Mac to run.

However, the following settings *seem* to work with the Mac CD on a Mac with the specifications:

System Version: Mac OS X 10.4.8 (8L127)

(Explorer 5.1 in OS 9 folder)

Kernel Version: Darwin 8.8.0

Boot Volume: Macintosh HD
